Mineral Lick: 100g – 125g/head/day. Mineral Bag (powdered): 125g/head/day.

GENERAL USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Mineral Lick:

- With reasonable access allow one block per five horses to ensure adequate daily intakes.
- A common practise is to place blocks in a car tyre at the desired feeding site.
- Intakes are stimulated by placing the blocks near a water trough.
- If intakes are excessive, blocks should be rationed by putting out a set amount at pre-determined intervals.

Caution: Do not exceed the daily intakes guidelines. No additional complementary trace element supplements should be fed without nutritional/veterinary advice. This block contains high levels of copper and should not be fed to sheep. It also contains high levels of selenium so care should be taken in known high selenium areas.

Mineral Bag (powdered):

• Complementary feeding stuff to be used as a top dress or mixed in feed including TMR.

Caution: this mineral contains copper and should not be fed to sheep. Do not exceed the daily intake guidelines.
